REQUIREMENTS

Students remain in the high school course and are dually enrolled in college for the second semester, if they meet the following criteria:

- o They have an 85% average or higher for the first semester
- o They have an 85% attendance rate for the first semester.



HILBERT COLLEGE

Students must be registered in the high school AP course. Students who do not meet these criteria remain in the high school course but will not be registered with Hilbert. Potential exceptions to this guidance must be reviewed and approved by the School's guidance counselor, principal, and ASL.

The students who are registered / enrolled at Hilbert will receive college credit and a Hilbert transcript if they pass the course, even if they do not pass the corresponding AP exam. They will also receive a high school credit.

ERIE COMMUNITY COLLEGE

ECC is offering the opportunity to earn 3 college credits to students enrolled in African American History and African American Literature. Students must pass the course in order to get the college credits.
