ANNUAL PHYSICAL EXAM & IMMUNIZATION REMINDERS



- 1 Book your student's annual appointment now to avoid appointments filling up
- 2 Ensure that all NYS required Immunizations are up-to-date. Students will be excluded from school 14 days after the start of school if they do not have updated NYS School Immunization Records (this does **NOT** include the COVID-19 vaccination)
- 3 Schedule a physical examination, especially if you plan to play a school sport, have had COVID, OR will be in K, 1, 3, 5, 7, 9, 11, for the upcoming school year
- 4 Send updated copies of the visit to your school nurse or email: medicalrecords@buffaloschools.org



ARE YOU IN NEED OF NYS IMMUNIZATIONS ? WE CAN HELP!

If you have a Primary Care Physician (PCP)...

- Call and state the urgency of needing a "shots only" or "nurse" appointment

Does the student attend PS 6, 27, 76, 89, 91/92, 93, 94, 97 or 99?

- Call the school and ask to speak with school based health clinic for appointment availability

If you DO NOT have a PCP...

2022-23 School Year New York State Immunization Requirements for School Entrance/Attendance¹

NOTES:

Children in a prekindergarten setting should be age-appropriately immunized. The number of doses depends on the schedule recommended by the Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices (ACIP). Intervals between doses of vaccine should be in accordance with the ACIP-recommended immunization schedule for persons 0 through 18 years of age. Doses received before the minimum age or intervals are not valid and do not count toward the number of doses listed below. See footnotes for specific information for each vaccine. Children who are enrolling in grade-less classes should meet the immunization requirements of the grades for which they are age equivalent.
